New Patient Evaluation Package

\$500 Adults

\$550 Children

Our *New Patient Evaluation Package* is a \$100 discounted package for our new cash paying patients. Our Bundle package includes the first three visits: 60-90 minutes Psychiatric Evaluation plus, two 30-minute Follow-up appointments.

Psychiatric Evaluation/Consultation for Adult:

\$300

Comprehensive evaluation which includes individual interview, diagnostic assessment, treatment plan and recommendations.

Up to 60 minutes.

Psychiatric Evaluation/Consultation for Child:

\$350

Comprehensive evaluation which includes interview with parents as well as child, diagnostic assessment, treatment plans and recommendations.

Up to 75 minutes.

Standard Comprehensive Follow-up:

\$150

Includes in-depth assessment of symptom progression, treatment planning and evaluation of medications. May also include brief supportive therapy interventions and recommendations for parent management techniques.

30 minutes

Brief Medication Monitoring Follow-up:

\$115

Included in-depth assessment of symptom progression, treatment planning and evaluation of medications. Used for patients who have had stable symptoms for at least 3 months.

Up to 20 minutes

Individual Psychotherapy:

\$250

Includes extended time to facilitate insight, interpersonal growth and develop problem solving skills. Appointment may be with the identified patient and/or family members. Appointments are usually scheduled on an ongoing and regular basis.

Forms and Letters:

Patients frequently request forms and letters for school, work, or insurance issues. Generally, we request that you bring these forms to your scheduled appointment and, if brief, they can be completed during your allotted appointment time for no additional charge. Longer forms and letters will be done outside of appointment time and the fee will be based on time involved to complete.

Simple (less than 5 minutes)	No charge
Moderate (5-15 minutes)	\$50
Lengthy (15-30 minutes)	\$100
Complex (over 30 minutes)	\$200/hour

Phone Calls:

Brief phone calls are an expected part of monitoring an individual's response to treatment. These calls should be made during regular office hours and there is no fee. If the provider will make every effort to return the call within 24 hours. If calls are increasing in frequency and durations, this may be a sign that you need to be seen sooner and you will be asked to schedule an appointment. Non-emergent calls made after hours will be billed at \$300/hr.

Copying Records:

Upon written request, records will be copied. It typically takes up to a week to have copies made. There will be no fee for records that are directly transmitted to other sources including another medical office, school or therapist. The fee for copying is:

\$20 for the first 20 pages
\$0.50 for each additional page

Forensic Psychiatry:

In most situations, it is not appropriate for a physician to provide clinical care and forensic psychiatry services (i.e. consultation to an attorney or the Court) for the same individual. If you have a request for such services, you will be asked to schedule a 45 minute appointment to discuss your needs, so that the psychiatrist can determine whether she can accept your case and provide the expertise that you require. **Forensic services are billed at \$400/hour.**
